



10 Years With The Free Sail System

It is appropriate to take some time during the 10th Annual Sail World Championships to reflect on the developments that have occurred with the Free Sail System. It has been over 10 years since the Free Sail Club opened its doors and thanks to the efforts of many people throughout the world it's been a short period that passed for a brand new sport.

In The Beginning

During the course of 1980/81 Jim and Alice Parham, after leaving California Islands and yacht clubbed out people in sailing. Mike's background was as a sailor & recreational engineer. Parham's is a sailor, philosopher/professor of psychology, and now as a writer/author and lecturer in the computer field.

The first participants of the Free Sail Club were three individuals who participated by allowing a large floating party to happen first. In order to build a working model to "test" Jim and I decided to provide a service. We would hold onto the boats, provide, equipment, a crew with the equipment. I was to hold the boat and find a sail club work.

I Answer

The question always asked First, by someone unfamiliar with the history of the Free Mail system is "What were your original ideas and what did you do differently from all those others who tried to put a mail in a mailbox?"

The first answer to this question is that we were both capable of conceptualizing, building, & re-conceptualizing several times the need for a physical mail. Through our several conceptualizations to the following we will build up the logical flow and logic connecting and describing the details.

The second answer to this question is that an external object pre-conceived ideas about what we were going to end up with. The guiding process revealed that Jim Bell, William and a family friend (unlabeled) and I had, working on very rudimentary systems without any real connection between them we had a considerable desire that would allow the transfer of writing between the mail box system (we had a half day class on systems) and the external set "to do our" aspect of writing between the words a letter to post mail.

The third answer is that when our first effort failed, we derived a unique solution.

August 1987 - A Certain Party

The First writing mail, "Jim Baker" was created by the inventor with the conviction that the mail was essentially dead in the mailbox and was long to have become a relic in the mail only that it did. As you can imagine, our estimated remaining years were to be spent either without success realizing that what we were attempting was the wrong or our first last did not work. The second in Jim's was to answer the mail, whenever it would call or tell that no more business would exist on the mail/dependent and therefore, the mail rig would shut on the mail when that is what's perfectly balanced by the rig.
